1. Chardonnay, £3.35 £4.75 £6.75 £19.95
 The Accomplice, Australia
 Medium bodied with lively peach and nectarine flavours finishing with a rich creamy texture and long fresh citrus zest.
2. Pinot Grigio, £3.65 £5.25 £7.30 £21.95
 La Delfina, Italy
 Offers lovely citrus fruit flavours on the nose accompanied by soft honey undertones. The taste is crisp and refreshing.
3. Sauvignon Blanc £4.35 £6.15 £8.75 £26.95
 Taringi, New Zealand
 Lifted notes of gooseberry and ripe guava on the nose and has a beautifully fresh, crisp palate that is fruity yet dry on the finish. this a popular, easy-drinking wine.
4. Albariño £5.00 £7.15 £10.00 £29.95
 Pazos de Lusco, Spain
 Meaning 'sunset' in the local Galician dialect, Lusco is a vibrant and full-bodied Albariño. Fresh and complex on the palate, the wine is unctuous, soft and refined.
5. Sancerre Blanc £5.15 £7.25 £10.30 £30.95
 Chateau Langlois, France
 Loads of gooseberry and passion fruit, with that characteristic flinty, fresh acidity.
6. Chablis £5.15 £7.25 £10.30 £30.95
 Seguinot-Bordet, France
 The taste is perfect harmony of maturity, mellowness and vivacity. The flowers and fruit reappear, enhanced by charming biscuity notes.
7. De Ladoucete, Pouilly-Fume 2014 £49.95
 Loire, France
 Ladoucette controls some of the largest vineyards in the famous Pouilly-Fume appellation, and the wines are characterised by the combination of limestone and clay found in the soils. Flinty and pure with punch fruit, and a beautiful, fresh acidity. (RP 91 points).
8. Meursault 1er Cru 2014, Domaine Faiveley £99.95
 Burgundy, France
 Beautiful aromas of citrus and stone fruit with a touch of minerality are reinforced by the incredible energy and vibrancy of this wine. Fresh and juicy, this is a joy to drink

 Lively and refreshing flavours of ripe strawberry and juicy watermelon combine with a delicate sweetness and crisp acidity.

 France
 Classic Provence rosé, elegant and delicate with an almost silky texture on the finish.

11. Malbec, Rio Rica £3.25 £4.50 £6.35 £18.95
 Chile
 Easy drinking, subtle bramble fruits with a lovely smooth texture.
12. Rioja Tempranillo £3.50 £4.95 £7.00 £20.95
 Hacienda Lopez de Haro, Spain
 Soft and easy drinking in style with mellow plum fruit flavours and a soft, smooth fruity finish.
13. Merlot £3.50 £4.95 £7.00 £20.95
 Franschoek Cellar 'Old Museum', South Africa
 Lashings of liberal ripe plums, red cherries and a touch of fruitcake spice.
14. Shiraz £4.35 £6.25 £8.70 £25.95
 Thomas Goss McLaren Vale, Australia
 Warm, ripe cherry and autumn berries with hints of damson and dollops of peppery spice that warms the finish.
15. Cab-Sauv-Merlot £4.85 £6.95 £9.70 £28.95
 Vierkoppes Weavers Nest
 Subtle hints of raspberries, cherries on the nose with autumn berry fruit flavours.
16. Pinot Noir Esk £5.65 £8.00 £11.30 £33.95
 Valley, New Zealand
 Subtle hints of raspberries, cherries on the nose with autumn berry fruit flavours.
17. Marques de Murrieta, Reserva Rioja 2010 £36.95
 Rioja, Spain
 Produced from grapes cultivated on the Ygay Estate, this classic Rioja wine is aged for two years in American oak, before resting a further 18 months in bottle. The vibrant red fruit flavours marry seamlessly with the vanilla and spice characters contributed by the extended ageing. (RP 93 points).
18. Chateau Nenin Fugue De Nenin, Pomerol 2007 £59.95
 Bordeaux, France
 Lovely rich and developed aromas of black cherries with a touch of cedar. Mature red and black fruit characters on the palate. Lovely smooth, silky texture with more plum fruit and plenty of freshness. (RP 87 points).
19. Chateauf-neuf-du-Pape, Colombo & Fille 201 £64.95
 Rhone, France
 A classic blend of Grenache and Syrah aged for 14 months in oak. The fruit is sourced from the Colombo family vineyards and made by the dynamic Laure Colombo, one of Rhone's rising stars.
20. Chateau Batailley, Pauillac 2007 £96.95
 Bordeaux, France
 The 2007 Batailley was created from 73 percent Cabernet Sauvignon and 23 percent Merlot, with the remainder Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Bright fruit and well-integrated oak combine and the complex cedar and forest floor notes are quintessential characters of the best elft bank wines. (RP 90 points).

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Magnums

26. Marques de Murrieta, Reserva Rioja, Spain £74.95
The vibrant red fruit flavours marry seamlessly with the vanilla and spice characters contributed by the extended ageing.
27. Gevrey Chambertin, Roche de Bellene, France £139.95
All the hallmarks of Gevrey-Chambertin are here. Generous fruit, aromatic spice and a delicate, well-structured poise. Made from grapes grown on 50-year-old vines taken from a two-acre plot. Seriously delicious.
28. Chateau Cantemerle, Haut-Medoc, France £159.95
Displays a dark ruby/purple colour, a lovely bouquet of forest floor, sweet cherries, cranberries, and black currants, medium body, a textured, sweet, tannic mouthfeel, and a long finish.
